COME OUT OF HER, MY PEOPLE. This phrase comes from the Book of Revelation (Gilyahna (Revelation 18:4), where Eloah calls His people to separate themselves from an evil and corrupt system symbolized by the ancient City of "Babylon." It is not a suggestion but a commandment. Regrettably, few people realize the seriousness and importance of the instruction. In the Torah context, Babylon represents a powerful religious system and elite characterized by the religious autocracies that developed soon after the Second Temple was destroyed. The call to "come out" urges believers to leave behind the pagan beliefs, practices, and traditions of the religions of the Roman Beast to avoid participating in Babylon's sins and facing its coming judgment. The truth is no one can exit the Beast unless you understand what she has done to the things of the Kingdom. Thousands of Hebrew words, Torah terms, and concepts have been Romanised or paganized, many beyond scriptural recognition:

- **YHWH** was changed to **LORD**.
- **Elohim** was changed to **GOD**.
- **Yeshua** (YHWH saves) was changed to **Jesus**.
- **Adonai** (Sovereign) was changed to **The Lord**.
- **Ruach Ha Kodesh** (The Set Apart Spirit) was changed to **The Holy Spirit**.
- **Ketivei Ha Kodesh** (The Set Apart Scriptures) was changed to **The Bible**.
- **Ivrit (Hebrew) and Aramaic** were changed to **Latin and Greek**.
- **The Mashiach of Yisra'el** was changed to **The Messiah of the World**.
- **Echad** (One) was changed to **The Trinity** (the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).
- **Malchut Ha YHWH** (The Kingdom of YHWH) was changed to **The Kingdom of God**.
- **Besorah HaMalchut** (The Gospel of the Kingdom) was changed to **The Gospel of Good News**.
- **Yerushalem** was changed to **The Vatican**.
- **Avinu** (Father) was changed to **Papa**.
- **Yisra'el** was changed to **The Church**.
- **Kahal** (The Hebrew Assembly or Congregation) was changed to **The Christian Assembly**.
- **Kiddush** (Blessings over wine and bread) was changed to **The Body of Christ**.
- **Brit Chadashah** (the Renewed Covenant) was changed to **The New Testament**.
- **TaNak** (The Hebrew Scriptures) was changed to **The Old Testament**.
- **Torah** (Instructions) was changed to **The Law of Moses**.
- **Moedim** (Hebrew Feasts) was changed to **Church feasts and holidays**.
- **Tikun Olam** (Repair of the World) was changed to the **Reign of Christ**.
- **Teshuvah** (Shuv) (Repentance) was changed to **Born Again**.
- **Kohen** (Priest) was changed to **Reverent**.
- **Rabbi** (Teacher) was changed to **Pastor**.
- **Kahuna** (Kohanim) was changed to the **Elders**.
- **Pirket Avot** (Saying of the Torah fathers) was changed to **Sayings of the Church fathers**.
- **Be Yah Shemo** (In the name of Yah) was changed to **In the name of Jesus**.
- **Miriam** (Mary) was changed to the **Virgin Mary**.
- **Kosher** (Set apart foods) was changed to **All is clean in Jesus's name**.
- **Shalom** (Peace) was changed to **Greeting**.
- **Berakhah** (Torah blessings) was changed to **Bless me my Father**.
- **Birkat Hamazon** (Food blessing) was changed to **Bless the hands who prepared this meal**.
- **Tefillin** (Phylacteries) was changed to **The Rosary**.

- **Tallit** (Prayer Shawl) was changed to **Prayer Closet**.
- **Talmidim ha Torah** (Disciples of the Torah) was changed to **The Disciples of Christ**.
- **Kadosh** (Set Apart) was changed to **Holy**.
- **Shechinah** (The Divine Presence) was changed to **The Glory of Christ**.
- **Tifereth** (The Esteem) was changed to **The Glory**.
- **Sheol** (State of abode of the dead) was changed to **Hell**.
- **The Shamayim** (The Heavens) was changed to **Heaven or Paradise**.
- **Shabbat** (The Seventh Day of rest) was changed to **Sunday**.
- **Pesach** (The Passover) was changed to **Easter**.
- **Yom Kippur** (The Day of Atonement) was changed to **Lent**.
- **Channukah** (Feast of Lights) was changed to **Christmas**.
- **Yom Rishon, Yom Shanee** (Day One, Two)... was changed to **Sunday, Monday** and so forth.
- **Tevet, Shevat**... was changed to **December, January** and so forth.
- **Da'at ha Elohim** (Knowledge of Elohim) was changed to **Know thy self**.
- **Safa Ha'Ivrit** (The Hebrew tongue) was changed to **Speaking in tongues**.
- **Sefirah** (Crowns) was changed to **The Crowns of believers**.
- **Gilgul** (Regeneration) was changed to **Bodily resurrection**.
- **Aliyah** (Return to the Land) was changed to **The Prodigal Son**.
- **Mikvah** (Baptism) was changed to **Sprinkling of water**.
- **Kaballah** (the Sohar) was changed to **Moves of the Holy Spirit**.
- **Shul** (School) was changed to **Bible college**.
- **Goyim** (Gentile) was changed to **The Lost**.
- **Tzadik** (Righteous) was changed to **The Faithful**.
- **Yetzer Ha-Ra** (Bad inclination) was changed to **Demons**.
- **Yetzer Ha-Tov** (Good inclination) was changed to **Angels**.
- **Synagogue** was changed to **The Temple**.
- **Bina** (A raised platform) was changed to **The Alter**.
- **Ma'aser** (The tithe of Yisra'el) was changed to **The Church tithe**.
- **Mitzrayim** was changed to **Egypt**.
- **Yam Suf** (Sea of Reeds) was changed to **The Red Sea**.
- **Kilyah** (Kidney) was changed to **Reins or Mind**.
- **Ohel** (Tent) was changed to **Tabernacle**.
- **Keporah** (Covering) was changed to **Atonement**.
- **Chen** (Favor) was changed to **Grace**.

Note: This is just the tip of the iceberg! Many Scriptures prohibit believers from changing the Words of Elohim. Do a little research, and you will see that none of these Hebrew words mean these things in English. The true Messiah did come to create a new religion based on a Greek and Roman identity but to revive the Old - the faith of the Patriarchs. **This is an Endtime commandment to leave the false religions of Babylonia and return to the Torah of Moshe.** Come out of her, my people, means learning the language and ways of Yisra'el and practicing it in our home so that when the Messiah returns, he will recognize us. Jewish, Messianic, and Evangelical congregations that practice Torah, Shabbat and the Feasts have nothing to fear from this commandment. The willful disobedience of the commandment in Gilyahna (Revelations) 18 will result in the rejection from the Kingdom of Elohim.
