



THE NARROW WAY. Shiloh warned, “13 *Enter in at the narrow gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leads to destruction, and many there be who go in that gate: 14 Because narrow is the gate, and difficult is the way, that leads to Chayim (life), and few there be that find it.*” Mattityahu (Matthew) 7:13-14. Notice the last part of his statement “*difficult is the way, that leads to life, and few there be that find it.*” What does this tell us? The way to eternal life is hard and narrow. What does he mean? We were raised to believe that killing animals, fish, and birds is natural and that they are part of the food chain and, therefore, morally permissible. Every religion has its “holy verses” that sanction the slaughter of these innocent creatures. Our holy men, among whom is the false Jesus, are portrayed as people who are carnivores. The rationale is that if they lived this way, we could all do it, too. Did not Yeshua caution us, ‘If the blind lead the blind, how can they avoid falling into the ditch together?’ (Mattityahu (Matthew) 15:14). **I will give you twenty reasons why taking the life of an animal, fish, or bird is morally wrong.** 1) Elohim is Love, and we are made in His image. 2) We are not human but angels having a human experience. 3) We are all connected together in the spirit. 4) Adam and Chavah were instructed in the diet of an herbivore. 5) We were given a mandate in the Garden of Eden to protect them. 6) We are not designed to consume flesh. 7) In the law of the Universe, it is murder to kill them. 8) Whatever we do to their kind, it will be done back to our kind. 9) They are our brothers and sisters in the flesh, for we share the same Father (YHWH) and Mother (Earth). 10) We need them as our friends and companions to survive on Earth. 11) They do not harm us, but they protect their family and home like any other living thing. 12) They fear us, respect our kind and they want nothing but peace. 13) They provide us beautiful gifts like milk, eggs, wool, clothes, honey, fertilizer, fuel, and their labor. 14) They protect us from physical and spiritual forces. 15) They want nothing from our kind but to give to us. 16) They are our most loyal friends and companions. 17) Heaven is full of their kind, and they are around the throne. 18) Together, they help us maintain the balance of Nature. 19) They warn us of dangers well before we realize what is happening. 20) They teach us many virtues like love, friendship, loyalty, faithfulness, courage, etc. I can give another 50 reasons, but what is the point if you do not open your ears and hear and your eyes and see and your heart and feel? The narrow road Yeshua speaks is the road of **Love of Elohim and our neighbors**, the two greatest commandments (Mattityahu (Matthew) 22:36-40). No one has told you this - **IF WE DO NOT STOP KILLING THEM, WE WILL BE SENT TO HELL** on the Day of Judgement. The system, as it has been from the beginning, is that when people die, they go to Heaven, and the bad few go to hell, but soon after, everyone is sent back here to continue their journey of enlightenment, redemption, and salvation.
